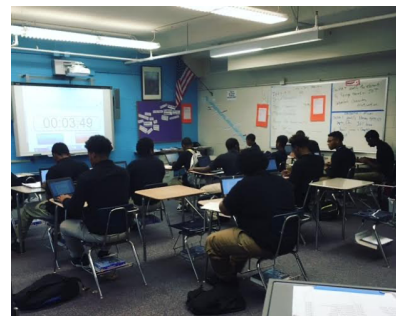
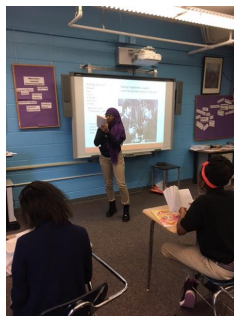




Calling all **OVER-AGED**

- Small, gender separated cohorts complete 7th grade or combined 8th and 9th grade curriculum to get back on track academically.



Who we seek:

- Motivated students who want to complete **TWO** grades in **ONE** school year.
- Students entering **7th grade** in fall 2023 at **13 years or older**.
- Students entering **8th grade** in fall 2023 at **14 years or older**.
- Students who want to attend a selective high school of their choice

What we offer:

- Project-based classroom instruction
- Safe learning environment with a climate support team
- 8th/ 9th program earns up to 7 high school credits
- Technology: Science lab, 1-1 Chromebooks, Smartboards in every room, WHYH Media lab

Enrollment & Eligibility Information

Crossroads Accelerated Academy will accept students who:

- Have successfully completed 6th and/ or 7th grade
- Students with ELL services
 - Bridging or emerging ELL
- Students who have been through the 21 process- on a case by case basis
- All students with IEPs and/or PTEs must be in compliance prior to enrollment
- Students who receive Special Education Services:
 - Specific Learning Disability
 - Other Health Impairment
 - Speech/Language Pathology
 - Hearing Support and Audiology
 - Occupational and Physical Therapy
 - Vision, Orientation and Mobility Support
 - Assistive Technology
 - School Based Counseling
 - Psychological Services
 - Transportation

Enrollment Process:

- Email sent to Principals and Counselors for referrals
- Families will be contacted to complete enrollment forms (electronically)
- Student & Family meet with principal or climate manager for orientation.
- An acceptance letter will be provided to student
- An acceptance letter will be provided to the school
- Students will begin on the first day of school (or the following Monday if the school year is already in session)

Enrollment windows:

- **April 5, 2023 – June 14, 2023**
 - Orientation and enrollment for starting September 5, 2023
 - For 7th and 8/9th grade spots
- **August 1, 2023 – November 16, 2023**
 - For 7th and 8/9th grade spots (depending on availability)
- **November 17, 2023 – January 20, 2024**
 - 7th and 8th grade spots ONLY (depending on availability)
